

















	<b>Business English B1</b>	
	<p><b>Can you find hidden messages in these logos?</b></p> <p>This logos lesson is based on a video about the hidden meanings of some logos and consists of different vocabulary and speaking activities that will get students talking about brand logos.</p>	Strong B1 participants

	<p><b>Communication is not that easy!</b></p> <p>This communication lesson is based on a short video presenting how miscommunication happens and how we can avoid it. The course includes vocabulary tasks, listening comprehension and speaking practice.</p>	
	<p><b>How to master working from home</b></p> <p>Thanks to this course you will learn some useful vocabulary, study verb patterns and watch a video about tips for working from home.</p>	

	<p><b>Functional language for online meetings you need to know</b></p> <p>You will learn some basic functional language for online meetings that you need to know. Later practise that in real-life situations and have some fun watching a comedy sketch.</p>	
	<p><b>How to be more productive at work</b></p> <p>This productivity lesson is based on two short videos in which Charles Duhigg presents his ideas for boosting work productivity.</p>	
	<p><b>How to make faster decisions</b></p> <p>This decision-making lesson is based on the concept of FOBO – fear of a better option. In this lesson, you will learn new vocabulary, discover some decision-making strategies and talk about your own experience.</p>	
	<p><b>Going Cashless? – Money and Payments Vocab</b></p> <p>Our cashless society lesson will engage you into a discussion on the future of money while learning some new money-related vocabulary.</p>	

	<p><b>Modern workplace amenities</b></p> <p>This Business English lesson looks at the modern office spaces and the cool office amenities we have. <i>It focuses mainly on practising speaking skills.</i></p>	
	<p><b>Workplace ghosting</b></p> <p>This lesson will make participants aware of such a phenomenon as workplace ghosting and introduce them to the world of statistics.</p>	(+ fractions in English)
	<p><b>How to ask for a raise?</b></p> <p>Business English lesson that focuses on teaching negotiation phrases and lets you have 1-1 negotiation role plays during your lesson!</p>	(negotiation phrases)

	<p><b>How to lead a successful global team + business idioms</b></p> <p>This is a Business English lesson on cross-cultural communication. Participants will learn verb collocations as well as business idioms and practise using them.</p>
